

Danica A. Buckley - Artistic Director & Conductor



Danica A. Buckley has been Artistic Director and Conductor of Cape Cod Chorale since 2014, conducting repertoire ranging from Bach to Sondheim. In 2016-17, the Chorale performed Vivaldi's Magnificat and Gloria as well as Haydn's Te Deum, all with chamber orchestra. In 2018 we featured music by the Beatles, as well as Ecce Cor Meum, a choral work by Paul McCartney. Spring 2022 saw the popular, uplifting, Celebration! Music of the 70s and 80s, when chorus, conductor, and audience danced in the aisles! In May 2023, Cape Cod Chorale joined forces with Choral Art Society of the South Shore to perform Fanny Mendelssohn's Hiob (Job) and Mozart's Requiem, accompanied by full orchestra and performed at Scituate and Mashpee High Schools.

Since 2005, she has been Artistic

Director and Conductor of the Choral Art Society of the South Shore. A highlight of her time there occurred for the 200th birthday of Mendelssohn and the 50th anniversary of the Choral Art Society in 2009, when the chorus performed a sold-out performance of Mendelssohn's *St. Paul* (jointly with Braintree Choral Society, also under Ms. Buckley's direction).

From 2006 until 2023, she directed the Simmons University Chamber Choir (Hitting a High Note Since 1902!). She served as Guest Conductor of the Colleges of the Fenway Chorus & Orchestra in 2021. She is a former UU Music Director, as well as for numerous community, university, independent school choruses, and music festivals. With various choral groups, she has conducted abroad in London and Braintree, England and in Sarteano, Italy. Summers of late have seen her singing abroad and visiting European colleagues, rehearsing with The Hallé Chorus in Manchester, England, and with Toonkunst Plus in Gouda, Netherlands, and most recently, leading a workshop with a church choir in Cong, Ireland, where she was also the guest soloist, and performed solo at a pub for the first time! Ireland is calling in summer of 2025.

In her mission to bring choral singing and community together, she founded Sing for Good in 2017, an annual-ish concert on Cape Cod, raising money for organizations such as Habitat for Humanity. Prior to that, in response to the Boston marathon bombing in April 2013, only six days

later, she gathered 500 choral singers, two pianists, two soloists, and four conducting colleagues to perform Brahms' Requiem at MIT to comfort the community and raise money for the One Fund. The concert raised \$15,000 and was viewed all over the world.

She holds the MM in Choral Conducting from Boston Conservatory, under Dr. William Cutter. At Westminster Choir College, she studied conducting in summers with Dr. Andrew Megill and vocal health science with Dr. Scott McCoy. She earned an MA in English at North Carolina State University, Raleigh. Ms. Buckley is a member of Chorus America and the American Choral Directors Association. When not conducting or singing, she is an English professor of composition and literature at Wentworth Institute of Technology and UMASS Boston.

Mijin Choi - Guest Pianist



Mijin Choi holds a Doctor of Musical Arts from the University of Minnesota in Collaborative Piano and Coaching, a Master of Music from the Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University, with emphasis on Vocal Accompanying, and a Bachelor of Music in Piano from Kyung Hee University. Her work as an educator has included faculty and pianist/vocal coach appointments at SUNY Binghamton and the University of Connecticut, University of Massachusetts, and South Shore Conservatory.

This past summer, Mijin served as a vocal coach and pianist for the 25th anniversary season of La Musica Lirica, in Italy. Other summer festival work has included Boston University Tanglewood Institute, Fargo-Moorhead Opera, and Franco-American Vocal Academy.

Mijin is a versatile pianist, vocal coach, songwriter/arranger and church music director, with more than a decade of experience working in the field of vocal, instrumental, and sacred music. This includes having worked as a pianist and vocal coach in recitals, operas and opera scenes productions throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia. She currently serves as the music director at Union Church in Waban, Massachusetts, a position she has held since 2021.

In addition to Mijin's musical career, she is also a chef, having graduated from the Cambridge School of Culinary Arts. This allows her to explore the relationship between music, food, and our human experience.



Program Notes

Gloria – notes provided by Michael John Trotta and edited by Danica A. Buckley

Commissioned by a consortium of 10 choirs for simultaneous nationwide premieres during the 2018-2019 season, this three-movement setting uses a tapestry of sonorous harmonies that are triumphant, reflective, and energetic to encompass both the history and the relevance of one of the oldest texts in the Christian tradition. The text dates back to the fourth century with notable settings by Vivaldi, Bach, Poulenc, Walton, and more recently by John Rutter.

Gloria in excelsis opens with a brief brass fanfare that sets the stage for the triumphant theme. The contrasting middle section on the text "et in terra pax" (and on earth peace) foreshadows the sweetness of the second movement before returning to the original theme, with rhythmically intensified brass and percussion underscoring.

Domine Deus provides repose and refreshment from the intensity of the outer movements. A legato contrapuntal theme is introduced, recalling the "et in terra pax" theme from the first movement. The second theme is delivered sopranos on the text "qui tollis," (who takes away) to which the choir plaintively responds, "miserere nobis" (have mercy on us). The final statement of the theme soars with a grace that sets the stage for the ending, which gently recedes as the listener is left with a sense of peace and wellbeing.

Quoniam Tu Solus is introduced with brass fanfare atop a virtuosic organ[piano] accompaniment, providing an energetic introduction for the choir who sings the brass motive on the text "quoniam tu solus sanctus" (For You alone are holy). Following this brief opening, a modal double fugue, based on the theme from the first movement, is introduced on the text, "cum sancto" (with the spirit). Each choral exposition builds in intensity, briefly punctuated by developments in the brass. The work ends in a rhythmic and joyous reprise of the first theme with all musical forces, culminating in a thrilling conclusion.

Ave Maris stella (Hail, star of the sea)

The text is a Vespers hymn to Mary, originating in the seventh/eighth century. Originally set for voice and piano in 1893, Grieg wrote his arrangement for chorus in 1898.
